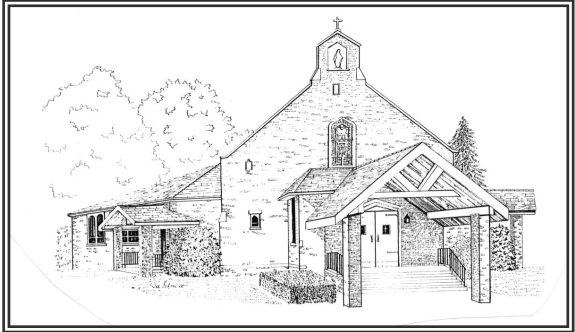
We ask this through Your Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ.

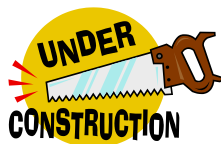

DEMOLITION—June 14, 2010

The church and Cassidy Hall will be closed to the public from this day forward until the renovations are completed.

PARISH OFFICE OPERATION

July 3 through date of completion

All weekend and weekday Masses will be celebrated in McKenna Hall at Rev. Brown School until the renovations in the church are completed.
